This award honors the academic achievements and potential of early career clinician scientists conducting original and rigorous clinical research projects. The grant provides each scholar up to \$30,000 of supplemental research funds, in direct costs, over 12 months to support awardees' current or developing research. In order to be eligible for the award, applicants must have extraprofessional caregiving responsibilities.
