Title: COVID Evaluation of Risk for Emergency Departments (COVERED) Project

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Sponsor CDC

Description This surveillance project will be conducted in 20 high-volume institutions treating COVID-19 patients. Enrolled health care providers (HCP) will participate in voluntary surveillance activities which include prospectively collected data on endotracheal intubations and other aerosol-generating, other unprotected high-risk exposure events, and SARS-CoV-2 serologies. Non-clinical staff will serve as the control group to capture the risk of community transmission and transmission between HCPs (separate from patient exposure) in the work environment. The HCPs will be followed for an estimated 3 months during the study period to evaluate serologic evidence of SARS-CoV-2 exposure and/or clinical symptoms of COVID-19 infection.

Who Are the Participants in the Trial? Emergency Department nurses who are treating patients in the ED, emergency physicians, and ED employees who do not participate in direct patient care

Will Any of My COVID-19 Test Results Be Available to Johns Hopkins Occupational Health or My Supervisor?

Positive nasal swab PCRs will be reported to Occupational Health Services by the Research Manager.
