

# Health Services Research (HSR) Collaborative Research Group (CRG) Demonstration Project Template

### Purpose:

The HSR CRG is soliciting proposals for demonstration projects that partner with a health plan to answer a key health services research question. We will be awarding \$30,000 to the winning proposal and sponsoring an in-person meeting focused on supporting and developing the project proposal and query development. In addition, we will provide the winning proposal with query development and distribution support through the Coordinating Center.

#### **Evaluation Criteria:**

- Potential funder(s) and/or funding mechnism identified for the proposed project is appropriate/feasible
- Project includes partnership with a health plan
- Proposed project addresses a significant research question aligned with the mission of PCORnet
- Project proposes appropriate methods and addresses limitations
- Stakeholders beyond the research team will be engaged in meaningful ways
- Proposed team has the skills and experience to carry out the project
