

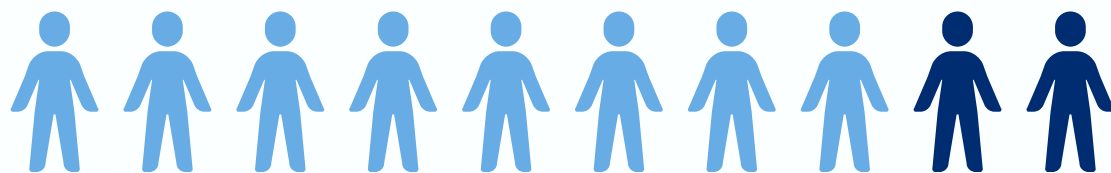
# Research Participant Satisfaction Survey

We review these results to help improve consent training, ensuring that research participants receive appropriate compensation.

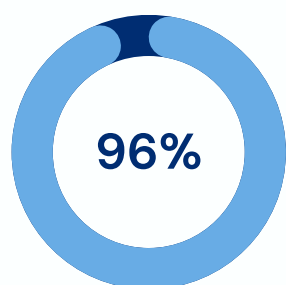
## Rating



75% of participants rated the research experience at 8 or better (out of 10), with 46% of these individuals rating their experience a 10.

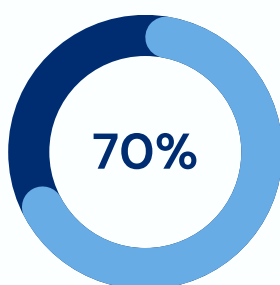


95% of respondents would recommend joining a research study to their friends and family.



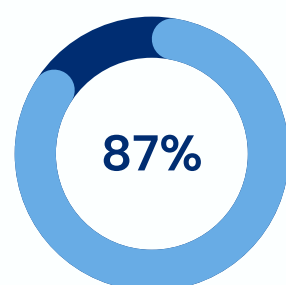
### COURTESY AND RESPECT

96% of participants felt they were **always** treated with courtesy and respect.



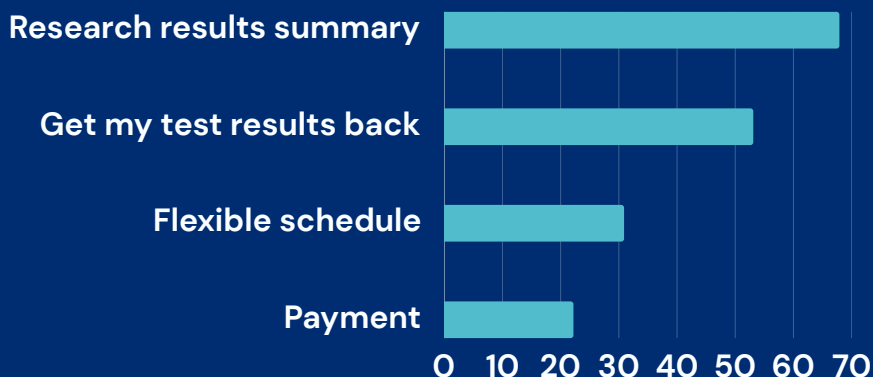
### VALUED PARTNER

70% of participants felt they were **always** a valued partner in the research process.

## 122 respondents completed the survey
