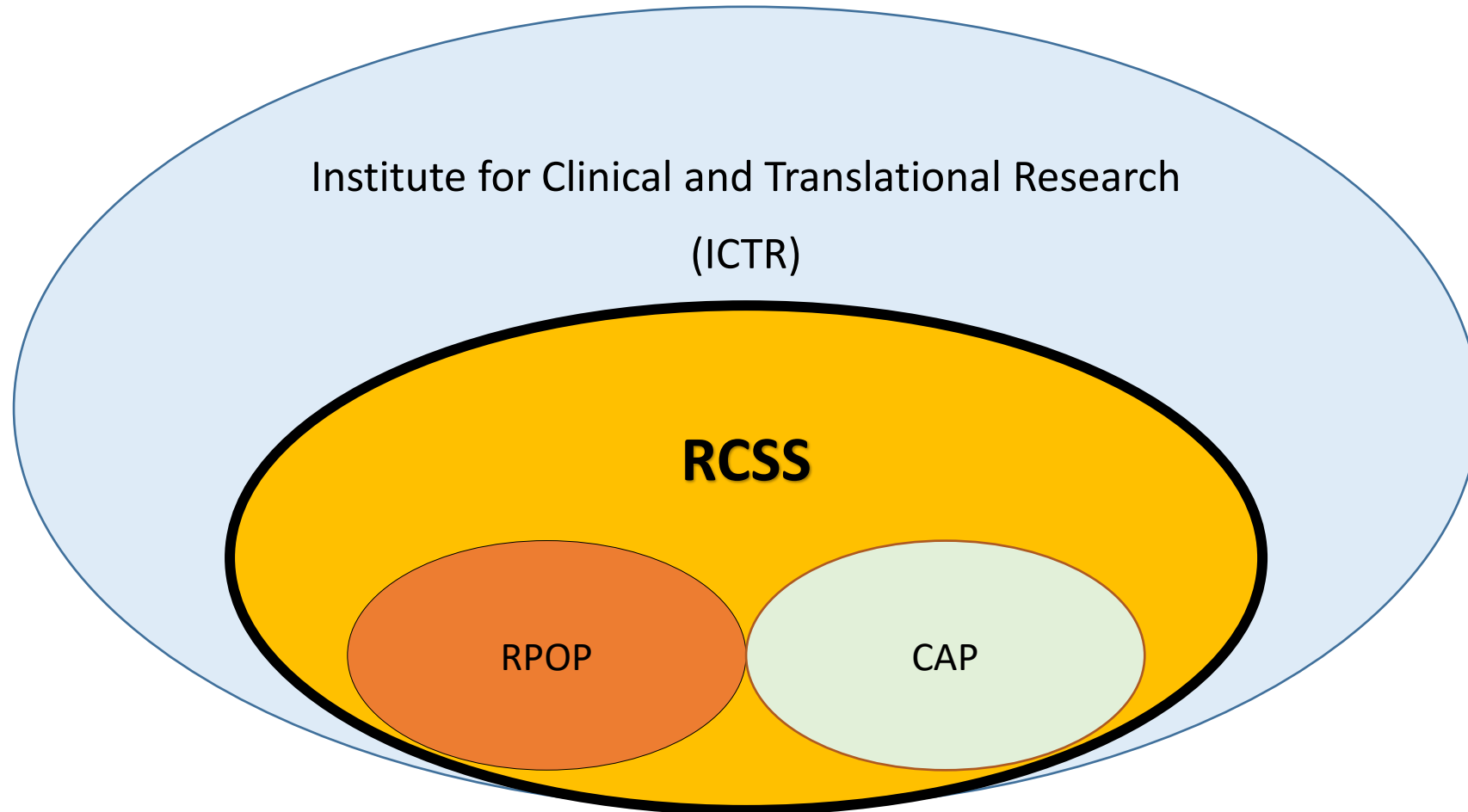

Research Coordinator Support Service



- A pool of research coordinators that are available for hire on a part-time basis by Johns Hopkins researchers.
- Since 2020
 - 246 requests, >30 different departments
 - >142 projects assigned to CRCs
- Current
 - 13 staff
 - 49 active studies

RPOP: Research Personnel Onboarding Program

CAP: Coordinator Apprentice Program

Overview of Program/Core

- SCAMP was established in 2012
 - Provide coordinator training to trainees with no clinical research training
- RCSS was established in 2014
 - Provide services to investigators who needed part-time research support
- SCAMP was re-branded as the Coordinator Apprenticeship Program (CAP) in November 2020

Program Efficiency

- Work Agreements
 - REDCap survey interface
 - Access database that automatically generates Work Agreements
- Monthly Invoicing
 - Wed-based hours tracking Tool (Clockify)
 - \$60/hr. - Apprentices, Coordinators
 - \$65/hr. - Regulatory Specialists, Sr. Coordinators
 - Detailed description of tasks done

Impacts

- The program has trained 59* coordinators since 2012
 - 85% (47/55) are still in research
 - 56% (31/55) are still at JHU (including Clinical RNs)
- Investigators have turned to RCSS
 - To take on projects they would normally have to turn down
 - To support research teams that have lost staff members or are overwhelmed
 - To supplement their own staffing/knowledge gaps
 - To grow research portfolios

*Percentages reported based on 55 we are still in contact with, as 4 are lost to follow-up

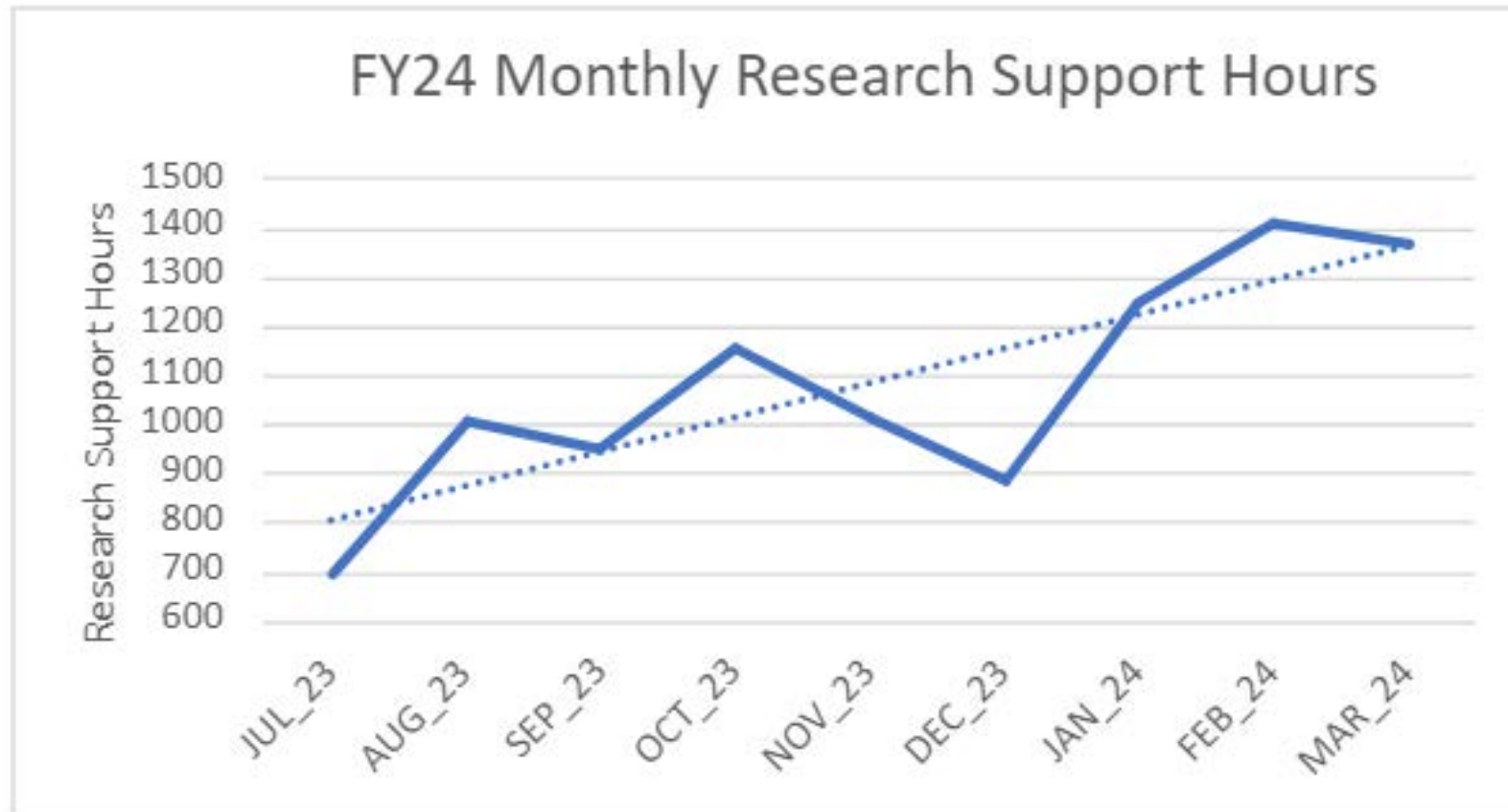

Research Personnel Onboarding Program

- RCSS quality of work → Multiple requests to train CRCs
- Launched in September 2022 as a pilot (for CRCs)
- Support Principal Investigators, Managers
 - Rapidly and efficiently onboard staff;
 - New to research
 - New to Johns Hopkins
 - Provide ongoing, project-specific support
- Assistants, CRC, Sr. CRCs, Research Managers and Visiting Fellows

Research Personnel Onboarding Program

- **39** requests since September 2022
- Most recent request was the 5th from the same PI
- + Many interested but waiting on funds to hire

- When?
 - As early as Day 1
- Where?
 - Online courses
 - Instructor-Led trainings
 - 1:1 mentoring sessions
- Why?
 - RCSS has trained 59 coordinators since 2012
 - Strong feedback, Surveys (Coming Soon)
 - Rapid, efficient and personalized

How to Work with us

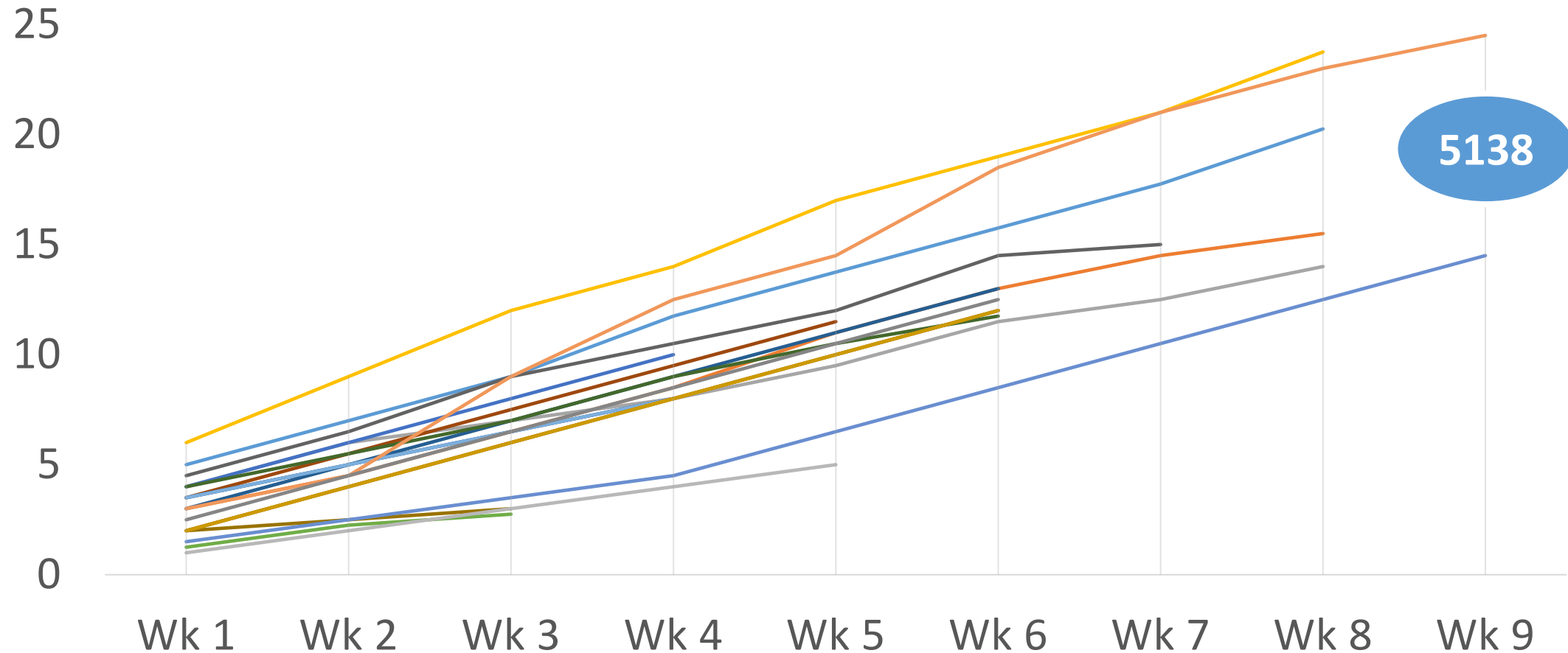
- Service request
 - PI's need, Study's need, Trainees' need and future goals
- Plan and report
 - Personalize a training plan
 - Menu (0 - >200) training hours
 - ~ **(6-8) weeks**
 - Weekly updates

RPOP Rates

- Develop and manage training plan (\$65/hour)
- Ongoing support by the hour (\$65/hour)
 - **29/36 (81%) requests opted in**

Impacts

 - Know they are being invested in

Implementation Process

1 Contact Lauren Davidson to setup call/meeting

2 Scope consultant/project need

3 Lauren provides proposal and/or cost estimate within 24-48 hours

4 Medasource provides consultants within 5-10 business days

5 As JHU SOM leader finalizes resources, Lauren will provide JHU with the three identifiers needed to create their JHED ID

a. Name

b. Date of Birth (DOB)

c. 9 Digit Social Security Number

d. Signed Consultant WFH Document if user is WFH

6 Lauren will create and share the SOW 1-2 weeks prior to the consultants start date

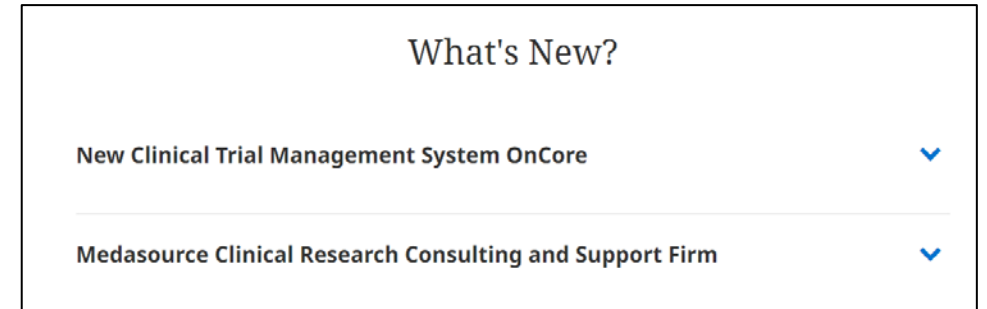
7 After review, hiring manager will submit SOW to legal for signature

8 Receive a Cost Center# for billing

9 Medasource W-2 contractor can begin work
