
Research Participant Satisfaction Survey

Of 500 participants invited to complete the survey, 106 responded



The majority of respondents were Female (69%), had a college degree or higher (70%), were 55 years of age or older (73%), and identified as White (67%).




88%

Overall satisfaction was highest among individuals who identified as Black or African American

64.3% of individuals who identified as Black or African American rated their experience a 10, compared to 46.7% of individuals who identified as White



of respondants would recommend joining a research study to their family or friends


