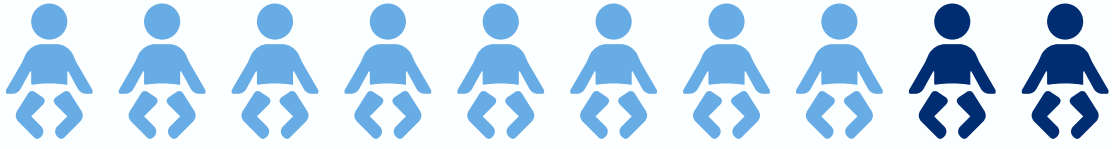


Children Research Satisfaction Survey

We review these results to improve the experience of our research participants when they join a study.

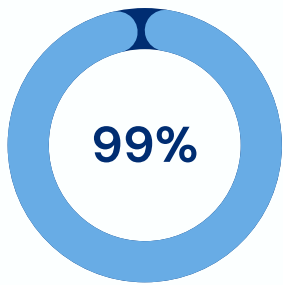
Rating



87% of participants rated the research experience at 8 or better (out of 10), with 48% of these individuals rating their experience a 10.

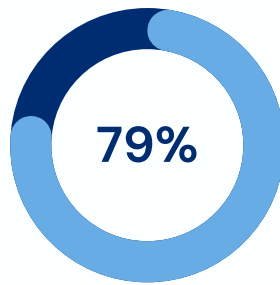


100% of respondents would recommend joining a research study to their friends and family.



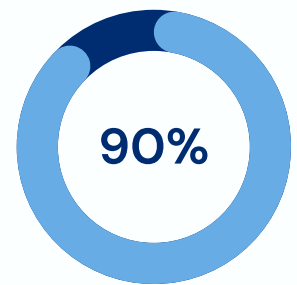
COURTESY AND RESPECT

99% of participants felt they were **always** treated with courtesy and respect.



VALUED PARTNER

79% of participants felt they were **always** a valued partner in the research process.



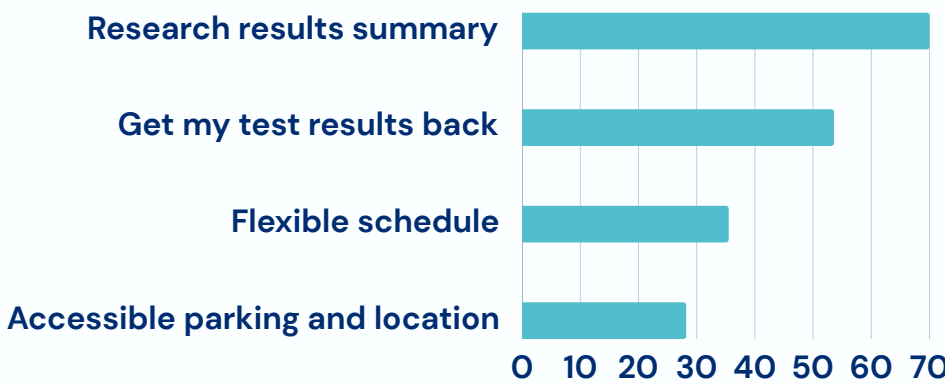
LISTENED CAREFULLY

90% of participants reported that research team members **always** listened to them carefully.

42%



42% of respondents indicated that participating in the research study at Johns Hopkins made them more satisfied as a patient at Johns Hopkins. The remaining 58% indicated there was no change in the level of satisfaction.



What do participants find important for future research participation?

127 respondents completed the survey



Most survey respondents were between 1 and 12 years old (60%), while 40% were younger than 1 year.

21% reported their race as other than White.
