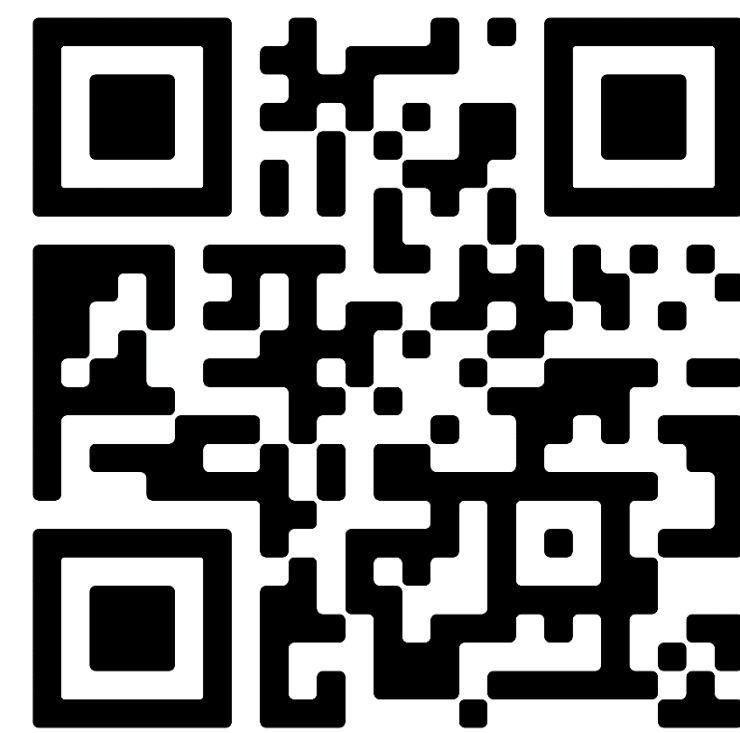
The ICTR Studio is a consultative process that is available to help investigators optimize the overall quality and ultimately the impact of their translational research studies.

Services Provided:

- A **multidisciplinary service center** that brings investigators together with the experts and resources needed to address their questions
- A **disease agnostic** consultation that is customized for each protocol or project
- A “**one stop shop**” in which systematic and immediate feedback is provided by a panel of experts who represent a wide range of content based and technical disciplines and are specifically selected to accommodate the unique needs of each presented project
- An **ongoing process** that continues to work with the investigator and help make any necessary adjustments
